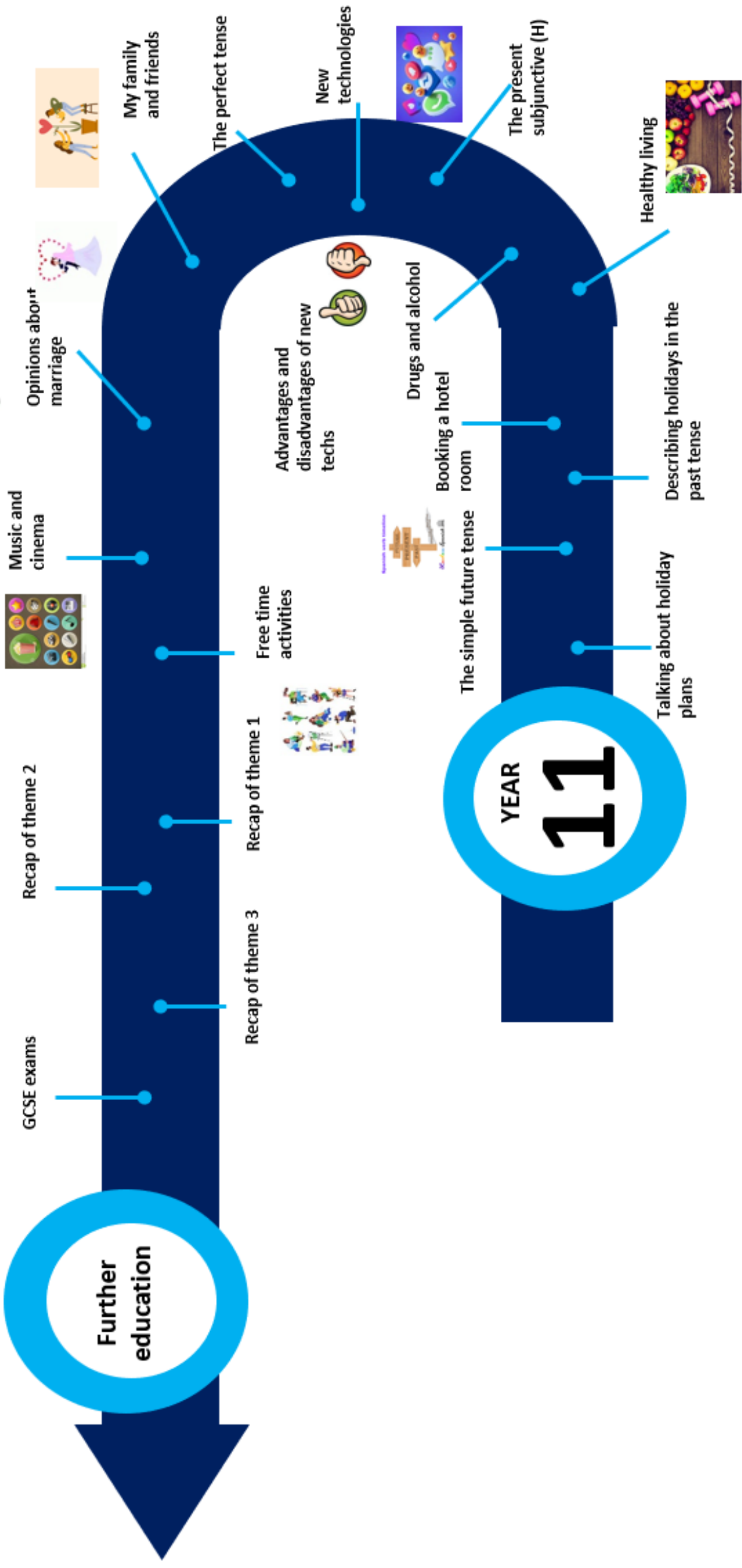


Year 11 Spanish Learning Journey

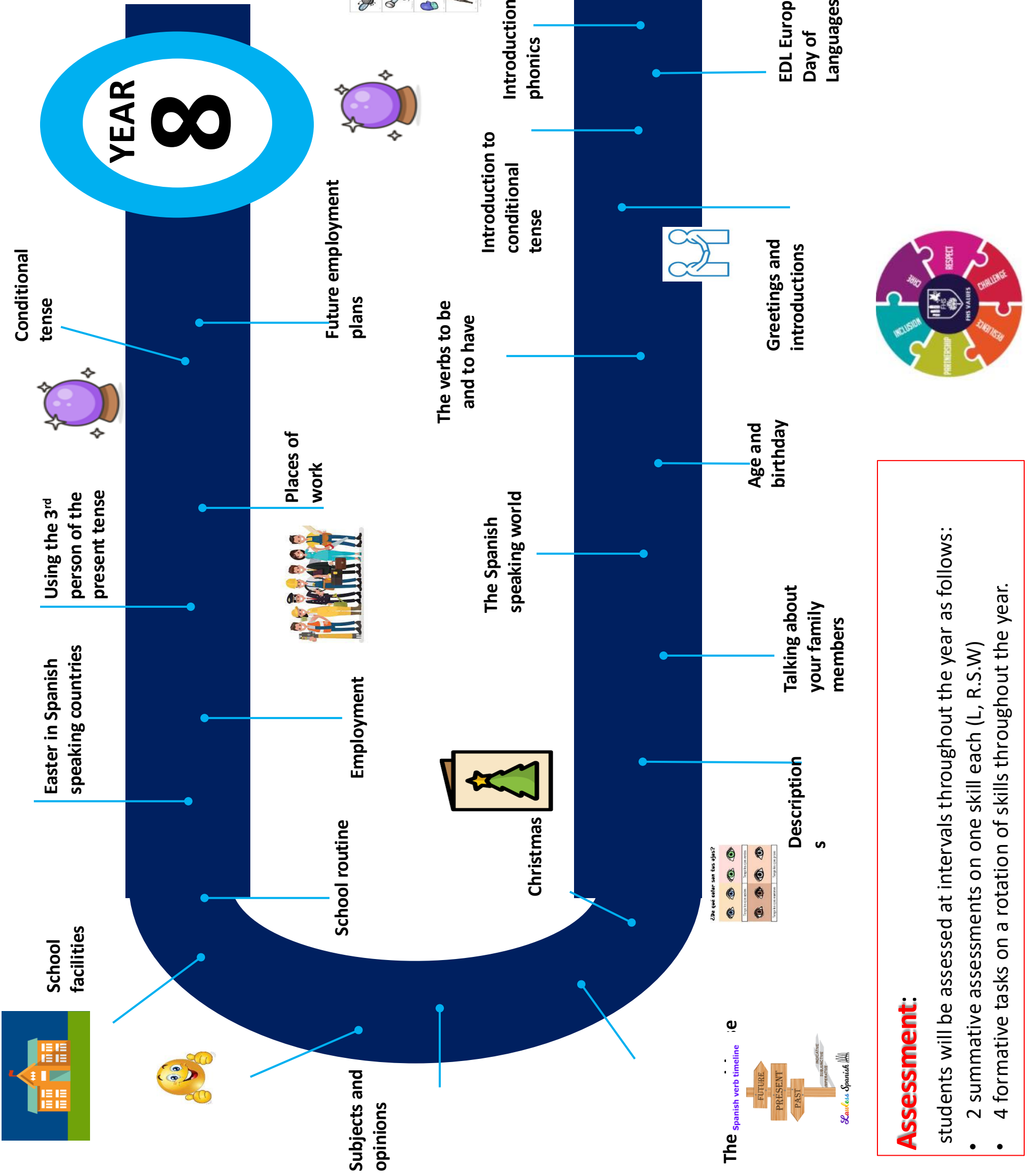

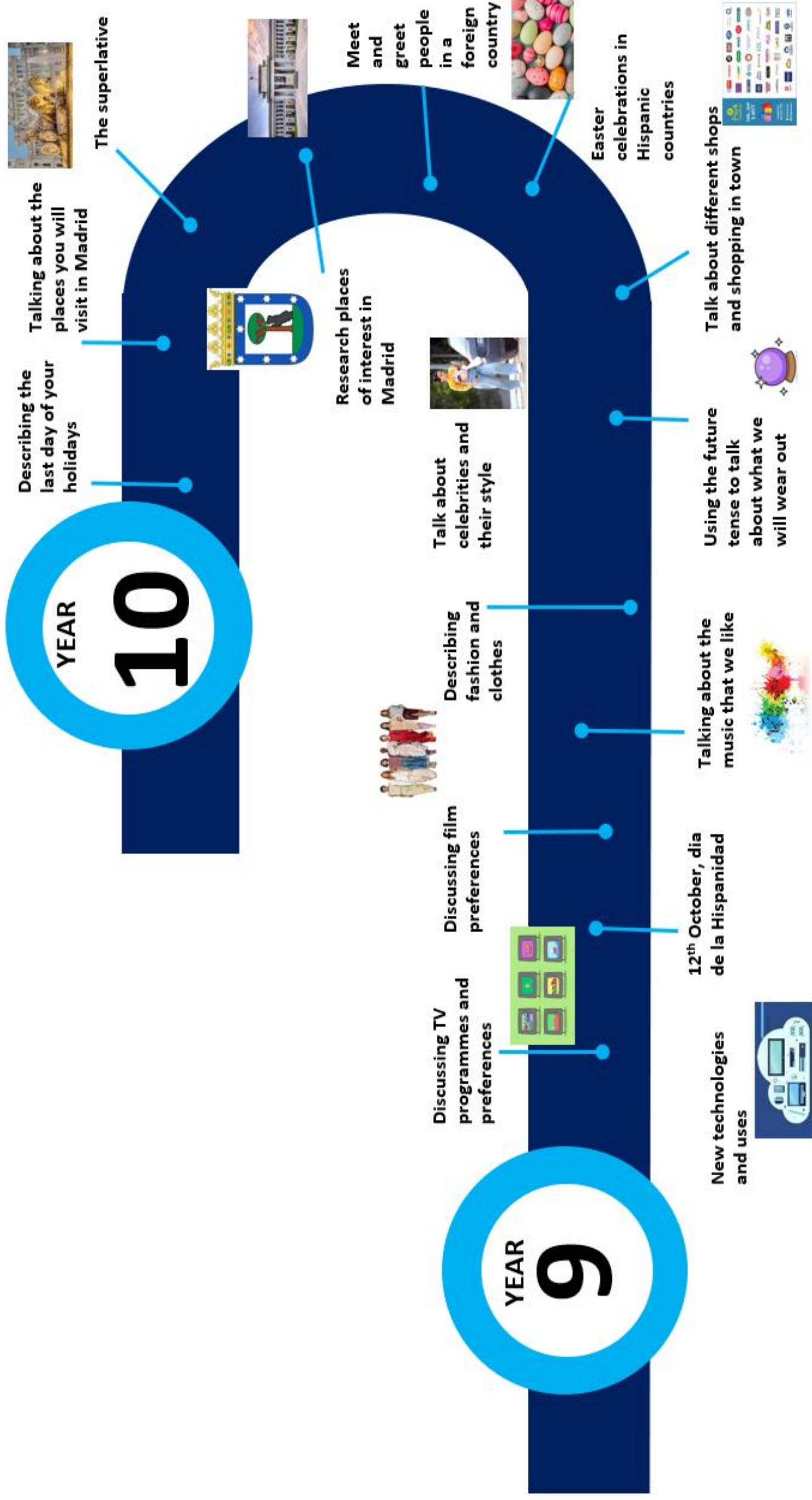

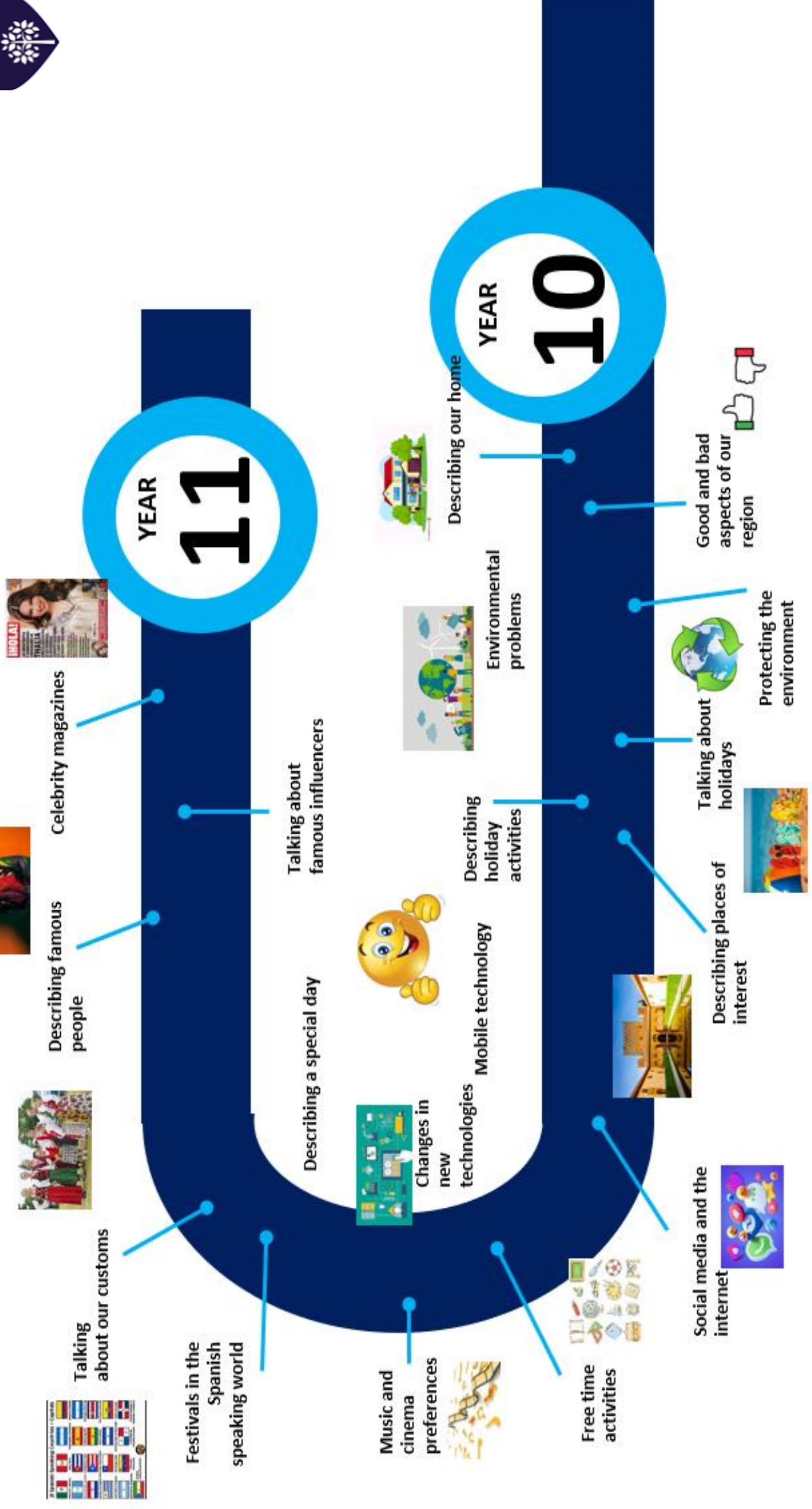
