RE: Curriculum Enrichment Activities

Many of you with older children in the school will be familiar with our curriculum week model, where we collapse the standard timetable for a week to offer a variety of activities aimed at deepening and enriching students' understanding of the subject curriculum. This model provides experiences that are often only available to young people in more affluent areas, fostering a sense of curiosity and broadening their horizons.

This year, the Curriculum Enrichment Days will be staggered into three parts. The first part will be held on Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st November. The next phase will take place in March 2025, followed by the final phase in June 2025.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in educational visits and workshops led by external professionals. These activities will occur during the school day, approximately from 8:30 AM to 2:30 PM (unless otherwise stated).
